Brookeville Receives “Planning” Grant for War of 1812 Bicentennial Celebrations

The Maryland War of 1812 Bicentennial Commission (Star-Spangled 200) has awarded the town a grant of \$20,000 for planning our “Nation’s Capital for a Day” celebrations in August, 2014. Michael Yesenko will be the Grant Administrator.

Lt. Governor Brown announced the awards at a ceremony on October 6, and gave each of the grantees a replica of the Star-Spangled Banner. Ours will fly from the flagpole at the Brookeville Academy. All the recipients are organizations and municipalities that are planning War of 1812 bicentennial celebrations in Maryland, including several sites of attacks along the Chesapeake, the Maryland State Archives, which is planning displays of historical documents, and the National Park Service at Fort McHenry. We’re in good company!
