The Schoolhouse Project

The Town of Brookeville applied for a HAWP (Historic Area Work Permit) for the one-room Schoolhouse to enhance the Schoolhouse lot and make it more appealing to visitors

- A wooden picket fence will be added along the existing chain link fence located on an adjacent property. As this fence is for aesthetics only, there will be no gates.
- A new brick patio will be installed in front of the Schoolhouse to be used as a gathering place for functions at the Schoolhouse. The patio may be accessed by a mulch path which will allow Schoolhouse visitors access to the natural part of the property.

The fence will be a 42" high pressure-treated pine wooden picket fence with simple square 4 x4 posts and 2"x3" rails and finished with an opaque stain. The patio will consist of a sand setting bed with brick pavers to match the 2 existing brick walkways at the Schoolhouse

The cost of these improvements will have minimal financial cost to the Town. Sandy Heiler has submitted a grant on behalf of the Town to cover the cost of the fence material. The Town has a pile of brick to be used for the patio. The Town will look for a community partner, such as a Scout group, to help with the fence and patio installation.

The Schoolhouse site improvements are part of the larger project to use the Schoolhouse in partnership with Heritage Montgomery.

ByPass Update

Commissioner Bartley has conferred with the SHA design team for the Brookeville Bypass and was advised the ByPass project will be advertised for construction bids on February 20, 2018. Notice to proceed (NTP) is expected to be June 4, 2018. SHA continues to negotiate with the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) for permits that are still pending.

Fall Clean-Up

October 27 – November 6, 2017

A dumpster for Bulk Trash disposal will be available to Town Residents October 27 – November 6, 2017. The dumpster will be placed on the Schoolhouse parking pad along North Street.

NEW THIS YEAR: Curbside bulk trash will be available on Wednesday, November 1, 2017. Residents must schedule bulk collections 1 week in advance with the Town Clerk. Email clerk@townofbrookevillemd.org or call 301-570-4465. All items must be placed at the curb by 7:00 AM on the day of collection.

What items are not accepted in bulk trash?

- Propane tanks
- Uncovered glass mirrors/table tops
- Debris generated from major construction, remodelings, demolition or repair work like bricks, concrete, lumber, non-metal fencing, shingles, drywall, paint, rock, sod, auto parts, tires, non-metal kitchen cabinets, sheds and large dog houses, etc.
- Dirt, yard debris, rocks, tree trunks
- Hazardous materials
- Human or animal fecal or uriferous matter; infectious waste; dead animals
- Large items that will not fit in the dumpster

Town of Brookeville's Seasonal Leaf Collection

The Town will schedule 2 bagged leaf collections this year.

Dates: Wednesday, November 1, 2017, & one date to be determined.

- Remember -- use only paper bags. No plastic bags are permitted for leaves.
- Limbs, rocks, other heavy objects, and trash must be removed.
- Leaves collected within the Town will be composted.
