Community Meeting held on Nov. 21

Town Residents gathered November 21 to hear Captain Marc Yamada, Commander of the 4th District Montgomery County Police Department, gave an update on the human remains found on Sunday, November 12. The remains were found in a shallow grave, approximately 18 inches deep, on the Inn at Brookeville's property. The remains were bones but not a full skeleton. As of this time, the investigators do not know if the remains are male or female or how long the remains were in the woods. The Medical Examiner's office in Baltimore will be performing an autopsy and hopefully provide investigators more information. There are no open missing person cases in Montgomery County and specify the 4th police district to match the remains.
