BROOKEVILLE WIND ENERGY NEWS By Fred Teal, Jr

Green Energy Quick Facts

Brookeville has made considerable progress in its campaign to switch to renewable wind energy.

- The average Maryland residence uses 12,500 kilowatt (KWh) hours of electricity per year.
- The total electricity used by the academy, schoolhouse, streetlights and residents during the past 12 months is approximately 720,000 kilowatt hours.
- The Academy and 25 residents are now using wind energy from Clean Currents in Rockville.
- Residents have chosen an average of 83% wind energy and 13% standard grid mix.
- The amount of renewable energy now being used is 275,000 kilowatt hours per year which is 38% of the town's total electrical energy use. We should pat ourselves on the back.
- One family has installed solar panels which generate about 3,500 KWh per year and a second installation for 9,240 KWh is in the works.

In addition, several residents have petitioned the Brookeville Commissioners to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for the inclusion of Brookeville in the "Green Power Partnership" program. If application is made and Brookeville is accepted, our town would become the first in the State of Maryland to participate in this program. We hope to propose that we can achieve the goal of 50% renewable energy use within the next six months. If you want more information on this program you can find it at:
