# Bill Gaskill Appointed as Town Commissioner

Bill Gaskill, was appointed to fulfill the remaining term of Buck Bartley. Commissioner President Daley made the appointment, filling the vacancy resulting from Bartley's January 1st resignation. Bill was sworn-in as a Commissioner at the January 8, 2018 Commissioners Meeting. Bill, his wife Patience, and their 2 children are North Street Residents.

The Town's charter permits the Commissioner to make appointments for Commissioners vacancy.

**Section 10. Vacancies on the Commission.** In event of a vacancy on the Commissioners for any reason, the Commissioners by a majority vote shall appoint some person, qualified in accordance with Section 4, to fill such vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term.

The Town is governed by a body designated as "The Commissioners of Brookeville," which consists of three commissioners. The Town holds elections each May for Commissioners, who hold office for a 2-year

Andy Spagnolo tendered his resignation effect January 9, 2018. After numerous years as a Planning Commissioner member, Fred Teal, Jr. is taking a well-deserved retirement from the Planning Commission, effective December 31, 2017. The Town Commissioners thank Andy and Fred for their volunteer service to the Town.

## Snow Removal Information

The Town of Brookeville contracts with a snow plowing service for North, South, Water Streets, the paved section of Church Street, and the eastern portion of Market Street.

The Maryland State Highway Administration plows High Street and the western section of Market Street.

During a snowstorm, no plowing begins until an accumulation of 4 inches of snow has fallen on the streets

Residents and businesses are responsible for clearing their sidewalks, driveways, and entrances within 24 hours of the end of a snowstorm.

All residents are encouraged to be good neighbors by clearing the sidewalks in front of their homes, as well as assisting those who may not be physically able to do so.
