

BYPASS UPDATE

Maryland SHA is moving forward with Brookeville Bypass Project. The current schedule below has been provided by the SHA Brookeville Bypass team. Construction is expected start this year.



WHAT: Construct a new, two-lane MD 97 (Georgia Avenue) highway around central Brookeville, from near Gold Mine Road to north of Brookeville, and including roundabouts at Gold Mine and Brookeville roads.

WHY: This project reduces traffic congestion in Brookeville and improves traffic operations and safety on existing MD 97.

WHEN: Design is approximately 99 percent complete. The current schedule is as below. MD SHA anticipates to open improvements to traffic in the Summer of 2021.
