Fiscal Year Budget for 2019

Nineteen Town Residents joined the Town Commissioners and Staff for the Annual Town Meeting at the Brookeville Academy, held on May 21, 2018. The draft Budget for FY '18-'19 was reviewed. The projected income tax revenue due to the Town has steeply decreased. The Town is estimated to receive between \$54K - \$60K per fiscal year in income tax revenue, instead of the \$100K - \$193K it has been receiving. This is due to errors in calculations by the State Comptroller's office in the years between 2010 -2014. The Town Commissioners will be analyzing the way the Town spend funds to ensure the Town stays financially solvent.

Flags Are Flying in Brookeville

All Town flags were hung on Memorial Day, May 28, 2018. Our streets look spectacular with our 15-star flags waving in the wind.

Thank You to Stefan Syski for organizing and recruiting volunteers. Stefan was assisted by Buck Bartley, Steff Kerr, Garrett Anderson, Pat Curley, and Duane Heiler.

The Town of Brookeville flies the 15 Star, 15 Striped authorized by the Flag Act of January 13, 1794. This flag was the only U.S. Flag to have more than 13 stripes. The flag design was changed by Congress with the Flag Act of 1818 which returned the flag design to 13 stripes and 20 stars for the 20 states.

The RainScapes Program

From Montgomery County DEP

The **RainScapes Rewards Rebate Program** offers rebates to property owners who install RainScapes techniques such as rain gardens, rain barrels, conservation landscaping and other approved projects that help control stormwater. This program is open to properties in Montgomery County.

The RainScapes Program is funded by the Montgomery County's Water Quality Protection Charge . The program offers a financial incentive in the form of rebates to property owners who install RainScapes techniques.

Eligible drainage projects include:

- Planting rain gardens
- Replacing turf grass with conservation landscaping
- Planting new tree canopy
- Replacing existing hard surface with permeable pavers
- Installing rain barrels, cisterns, dry wells,
- Removing Pavement.
