#### **Proceedings**:

# **Open forum for Town Residents**:

## **ROUTINE TOWN BUSINESS:**

- Minutes: The November meeting minutes were approved.
- Budget:
  - Local Income Tax: The Treasurer talked to Jim Peck about how local tax is calculated. Local income tax can fluctuate year to year due to income.
  - Debt Survey was returned to the State; the Town has zero debt
  - The budget was reviewed

## **TOWN OPERATIONS:**

- **309/311:** Commissioner Johnson will follow-up with another phone call to the inspector; he states it is time to have the Town lawyer draft a letter on behalf of the Town to the Code Enforcement office.
- **Semi-Annual Meeting**: The Clerk will request a representative to provide a bypass update at the Jan. 28<sup>th</sup> meeting
- **Rental Report**: Events Manager is out sick
- Garbage Can: request was made to move the Academy's trash cans more promptly after trash is picked up

## **TOWN PROPERTY**

- Academy:
  - **Roof:** MHT grant workshop is Wednesday; grant paperwork is due in March
  - **Interior / Exterior:** no progress on maintenance (window sills, microwave shelf, etc.); dehumidifier for basement has been ordered and will have a gravity fed drain; bathroom sinks will need new supports
- Roads:
  - Market St. potholes patched for \$5,400
  - o The contractor estimated \$70K to repave Market St, and quote does not include curbs
  - Gravel roads are in good shape

- **Schoolhouse**: boulders will be moved around the schoolhouse to help protect the lot & markers will be placed for wintertime.
- Trees:
  - **Tree Collaborative:** Quotes are still in progress; once the quotes are reviewed and a contractor selected, Residents will be given their quotes for acceptation/decline. Permits are estimated to be submitted in January. Residents who recently took down trees without permits will be asked to submit permits & fee retroactively

## PUBLIC WORKS

• Streetlights: Contractor will be coming to service a few lights that are out

# <u>BPC</u>:

- Pepco permits: Commissioner Daley signed the Pepco tree removal permits
- **Trees adjacent 301 Market:** Commissioner Daley signed the tree removal permits for the Haris property and trees on the Town's ROW, pending HPC approval
