## Market Street Repair Funding

The Governor of Maryland has allocated \$100,000 in funds for the repair and repaving of East Market Street. The State funds must be matched by the Town funds. More details regarding the timeline of the repairs to Market Street will be forthcoming.

## EPA Green Power Community

At the April Commissioners Meeting, the Town Commissioners voted to continue participation in the EPA Green Power Community Program by renewing the Town's commitment to purchase "green" electric power. The Town of Brookeville became an EPA Green Power Partner in August 2010. The Town was the first community in Maryland to achieve this status. Fred Teal, Jr. reports that in 2010, about 36 homes signed to purchase wind energy and the Town committed to acquiring 100% wind energy for the Academy and Schoolhouse, and Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) for the Streetlights.

Town Residents will be receiving a survey in the next few weeks to determine who is using "green" electric power. Many Thanks to Fred Teal, Jr for his efforts to keep the Town of Brookeville "green."
