Annual Town Meeting Review New Commissioners Sworn In

Approximately 20% of the Town attended the Annual Town Meeting held June 10, 2019, at the Brookeville Academy. Sue Daley, emeritus Commissioner, administered the Oath of Office to Garrett Anderson and Jeff Johnson, emeritus Commissioner, administered the Oath of Office to Mark Davis. Anderson and Davis were elected to service a 2-year term as Town Commissioners on May 14, 2019.

The draft Fiscal Year Budget for 2020 was shared and discussed. The budget is comparable to our current budget. There is a projected \$23,800 deficit for FY '20. There is a projected \$188,050 in Capital Improvement Expenses, which will be taken from the Town's reserve funds if needed. The Capital Expenses are \$100,000 grant match for east Market Street, \$70,000 for the Academy roof replacement, and \$18,050 misc. capital expenses. The Town has currently spent 50% of its operating budget for this fiscal year.

The Town has applied for a Maryland Heritage Areas Authority Grant to pay for the new standing seam metal roof for the Academy. The grant announcement is expected in July. The Schoolhouse improvements are being performed, partially funded by a Maryland Heritage Areas Authority Grant.

The design and repair of east Market Street was discussed, with a lot of input from Town Residents regarding calming traffic solutions. The Town will match the State grant of \$100K within the next 2 years for this project.

BPC Chair, Harper Pryor, reported the BPC had 3 reoccurring agenda items they have been working on:

- Tree removal permits
- Parcel 770: the proposed sub-divide of 4.3 acres of land adjacent to the cemetery
- Updating the Comprehensive Plan: The BPC is working with Montgomery County transportation planners for streets, sidewalks, and walkability for the post ByPass era. Priority is now focused on east Market Street and traffic calming measures.

Traffic calming measures throughout the Town was a much-discussed topic during the Annual Meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 7:52 pm with a heartfelt thanks to Sue Daley and Jeff Johnson for serving as Commissioners.

The Town of Brookeville flies the 15 Star, 15 Striped flags authorized by the Flag Act of January 13, 1794. This flag was the only American Flag to have more than 13 stripes. The flag design was changed by Congress with the Flag Act of 1818, which returned the flag design to 13 stripes and 20 stars for the 20 states.
