RESOLUTION 20-01
U.S. Bicycle Route 1 (USBR 1) through the Town of Brookeville

WHEREAS, bicycle tourism is a growing industry in North America, contributing \$47 billion a year to the economies of communities that provide facilities for such tourists; and

WHEREAS, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) has designated a *corridor crossing Maryland to be established as United States Bicycle Route 1 (USBR 1)*, and

WHEREAS, the Adventure Cycling Association and Bike Maryland, with the cooperation of Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT), have proposed a specific route to be designated as USBR 1, and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of our Community that the Town to support AASHTO, MDOT and the Adventure Cycling Association in its efforts to designate Market Street to be a portion of USBR 1, and

WHEREAS, the Town has investigated the proposed route and found it to be suitable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners of Brookeville hereby express its full support for the advancement of USBR 1.


