Bypass Update

SHA has been busy this summer with sewer, waterline, bridge, and road (driving surface) work. The Brookeville Bypass is now 70% complete and estimated to be finished by year-end 2022.

Parcel 770

The owner of Parcel 770, the 4.3 acres of land adjacent to the cemetery, building permits were approved at the July 12, 2022, BPC meeting. Construction will not commence for several more months due to permits needed by the County and SHA. Also, the lots for the four homes need to be created and the plats recorded.


Once constructed, the newest address in Town will be 19, 21, 23, and 25 High Street.
