Public Meetings for the Town

Public Meeting

- For public business to be performed in an open and public manner.
- Open for the public to observe.
- All public meetings will be recorded.
- The public is not allowed to speak unless they are prompted.
- Speakers should identify themselves before speaking.

Public Comment

Any person desiring to address the Commissioners or Planning Commission must:

- Wait to be recognized by the chair of the meeting before speaking.
- State your name and address prior to making a comment.
- Be directed to the matter being considered except during the portion of the agenda for public comments on matters other than agenda items.

Decorum

- All people shall preserve order and decorum at meetings for the Town of Brookeville.
- Meeting attendees shall courteously conduct themselves and be respectful.
- Any person who makes personal attacks or impertinent, defamatory, offensive, or threatening remarks, or who refuses to abide by these Rules or who remains boisterous after being asked to stop doing so by the President and/or Chair, shall be barred from further attendance at the meetings by the President and/or Chair unless a majority vote of the Commission grants permission for continued attendance.
- "Agreeing to disagree" respectfully.

Zoom Attendance

- Mute your microphone when you aren't speaking.
- Be mindful of background noise and distractions around you.
- The public is not allowed to speak unless they are prompted.
- Speakers must have their cameras turned on to address the Commissioners or Planning Commission.
