- Budget:
 - o The budget was reviewed.
 - \circ The auditor will be in the Town office on 9/13.
- BPC: The draft RFP for the Market Street Streetscape design project is a work in progress.
- **Parking Notice**: the mailed parking notice for 309/311 Market was returned as undeliverable. The violation notice will be sent via email. MoCo Code Enforcement will try to remove the inoperable vehicles in the next 30 days.
- Grants
 - o All grant paperwork for the Town must be stored in the Town's shared drive.
 - Heritage Montgomery Mini-grant: several projects were discussed
 - Repoint the stone wall in front of the Academy
 - Replace the front door of the Academy
 - Parking sign for the corner of Church and High Sts.
 - Outdoor lighting at the Academy
 - Relocate the light pole fixture to the side door (the light pole is currently not in use).
 - Sandy Heiler's request: a survey marker at the Madison House
 - o Clean Water Montgomery: potential grant for tree planting
 - o Sidewalk grant: not awarded as of yet.

Academy:

- o Stonewall:
 - set a cap to repair the one hole over the winter or start the project before the streetscape.
 - State grant: how does the competitive bid process work when you need a historical preservation contractor?
- Acoustic: the Academy noise reductions while events and meetings occur. Commissioner Ennis will
 contact a vendor he knows that handles acoustic ceiling tiles. Property manager will find the acoustic
 report from a few years ago.

• Town-maintained infrastructure & ROW

- o All Town sidewalks will be scheduled to be power washed. Property manager will get the cost for bi-annual power washing of the sidewalks
- Water St landscaping: per the BPC's request, they want to review the landscaping project. The price and project will be revisited next month.
- o SHA MOU for Rt 97 Maintenance: no update
 - A request was made to SHA to trim the vegetation along E. Market St.
- Streetlights
 - Price is being sought to refurbish the existing light poles
 - Pepco: Commissioners are changing the Pepco to teardrop Federal style overhead lights.
 - Both Town lights and Pepco lights may need to be moved if sidewalks are installed on High St.
- Tree Montgomery: trees should arrive in the springtime.
