

RESOLUTION 24-03
ADOPTING THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN OF 2024

WHEREAS, the 2024 Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) was developed by a team of Montgomery County agencies, municipalities, utility companies, and community and volunteer organizations; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan has been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) on May 29, 2024, and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan was adopted by the Montgomery County Council on June 25, 2024, by resolution number 20-557; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Brookeville recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking the hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects;

WHEREAS, the Town of Brookeville participated in the planning process with Montgomery County to prepare a Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Brookeville Commissioners, hereby adopts the 2024 Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

The Town of Brookeville will continue to participate in the updating and expansion of the Montgomery County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan in future years, and

The Town of Brookeville will further seek to encourage the businesses, industries, and community groups operating within and/or for the benefit of the Town of Brookeville to also participate in the updating and expansion of the Montgomery County Multi- Hazard Mitigation Plan.
