Reduction in Speed Limit

Dear Brookeville Residents,

We are pleased to announce the State Highway Administration has approved our request to lower the speed limit from 30 MPH to 25 MPH through town and to remove much of the Route 97 legacy signage throughout Brookeville. These two changes are expected to take effect within the next 60-90 days.

With the completion of the bypass and new traffic patterns, we are doing everything we can to make Brookeville a safe and peaceful historic village for our residents and their guests. We believe these two changes are a significant step toward making Brookeville safer for everyone, particularly our pedestrians and children.

In Montgomery County, All fireworks are illegal to possess or discharge

Montgomery County Fire Safety Code: [Section 22-70: Fireworks](#).

It is illegal for any person to manufacture, possess, store, offer for sale, sell, discharge, use, burn or explode any fireworks in Montgomery County, Maryland, except that an authorized display may be conducted by a licensed pyrotechnic professional with a permit. Penalties for violations of the law include a fine up to \$1,000 and/or six months in jail.

Residents should call the Montgomery County Non-Emergency line at 301-279-800 to file a complaint for violation of Fire Safety Code.

Coming soon! Order your free COVID-19 Tests at the end of Sept.

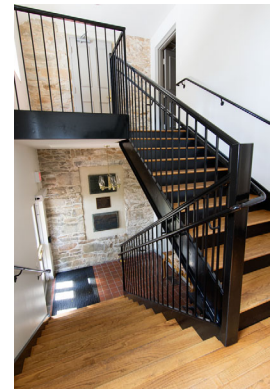
U.S. households will be eligible to order 4 free COVID-19 tests at COVIDTests.gov
