## News from the BPC

At the October 1<sup>st</sup> BPC Meeting, there will be no permits on the agenda.

In September, the BPC conditionally approved the building permit application for 1 High Street. The redevelopment of 1 High Street should start in the next few days.

The Town's Historic Area Workplace Permit (HAWP) for the Water Street modification project was approved on September 30, 2024. The BPC will hold a meeting on Thursday, October 10, 2024, at 7:00 pm via Zoom to review and approve the permit. You may review the permit at this link:

If the wooden pole does not have a pole number, please report the location of the streetlight.

## Montgomery County Historic Preservation Tax Credit

Did you do work on your home this year? If so, you may be eligible for tax credits through our Historic Preservation office! The Town of Brookeville is listed in the Montgomery County Master Plan for Historic Preservation, and all homes within the Town's municipal boundaries are eligible to apply for the Historic Preservation Tax Credit.

- Examples of eligible projects include, but are not limited to,
- Painting
- Repairing roofs or windows or replacing them in-kind
- Repairing architectural trim or ornament
- Uncovering and repairing original siding
- Repointing brick or stone foundations or chimneys
- Restoring a documented feature such as a dormer or porch that was previously altered or removed
- Repairing and maintaining outbuildings such as barns and garages

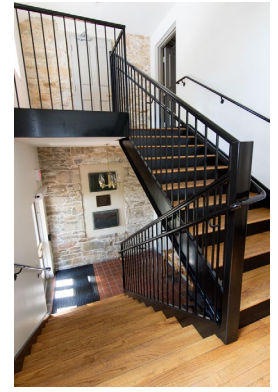
