The Commissioners requested and were granted a waiver of the annual audit requirement: Local Government Article, 16-305 of the Annotated Code of Maryland – Annual Audits

- (b) Unless the Legislative Auditor determines, on a case-by-case basis, that more frequent audits are required, the Legislative Auditor may authorize a municipality or a special taxing district created by the State with annual revenues of less than \$250,000 in the prior 4 fiscal years to have an audit conducted once every 4 years.

Montgomery County's Food Scraps Recycling Program

Recycle Your Halloween Pumpkins and More at the Montgomery County's Food Scraps Recycling Drop-Offs

Are you looking for a place to start recycling your food scraps or maybe your Halloween carved pumpkin? Montgomery County's Recycling and Resource Management Division/Waste Reduction and Recycling Section has launched its Food Scraps Recycling Drop-Offs at four farmers markets throughout the County. The Food Scraps Recycling Drop-Offs provide an opportunity for any Montgomery County resident to drop-off their food scraps to be recycled through composting.

The Food Scraps Recycling Drop-Offs operate at Olney Farmers' and Artists Market, year-round at the intersection of Maryland 108 and Prince Phillip Drive. Operates Sundays from 9 a.m.-1 p.m.

Residents can recycle the following food scraps at the drop-offs:

- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Cooked food
- Meat, fish, and bones
- Dairy (cheese and yogurt)
- Eggshells
- Bread and grains
- Coffee grounds and tea leaves (remove filters)

We ask that you remove any rubber bands or twist ties from fruits and vegetables before adding them to the carts at the food scraps recycling drop-offs.
