# **ROUTINE TOWN BUSINESS**

- **Meeting Minutes**: The November meeting minutes were approved.
- Budget:
  - o Budget vs. Actual was reviewed.
  - o The Commissioners will develop a ROM for the desired street work for planning purposes.
- **Semi-Annual Town Meeting**: Wednesday, February 19<sup>th</sup>
  - o The preliminary agenda was developed.
- Rental Report:
  - o There have been 17 income generating events this fiscal year
  - o Cub Scouts did not renew their meeting lease.

### **Town Operations**

#### **BPC**:

- **Streetscape RFP**: no progress to report
- Permits for Approval
  - o 309 Market: approved as submitted
    - a. Demolition of the outbuilding and deconstruction of the wall
    - b. Tree removal.

### **Grants**

- **MEA CLEG Grant:** 15 light fixtures and hardware to be ordered and delivery should be in 12 14 weeks from Spring City.
- Historic Preservation Capital Grant: working on Scope of Work
- **Heritage Montgomery:** 2<sup>nd</sup> extension

### **RPFs**

- Bids are in for the current RFPs
  - o RFP 2024-001-00 Street Light Post Painting
    - 2 bids received from CertaPro and Choice Contracting (lowest bidder); one quote is forthcoming
  - o RFP 2024-002-00 Street Light Installation

- 2 bids received from Bogin (\$3084) and Lighting Maintenance (\$3708)
- 3 wooden poles refurbished: Bogin (\$1467) and Lighting Maintenance (\$3708)
- Replace the light pole in front of 308 Market will need a new estimate from Pepco, which should be about \$2000 to relocate the power supply.
- The following items were unanimously approved:
  - o Purchase streetlight from Spring City for \$28,446
  - o Install light fixtures Bogin
  - o Painting Choice Contracting
  - Move forward to relocating and installing pole on Market Street
  - o 3 wooden poles refurbished Bogin

\$4632 sign from Lakeshore (\$2150) mini grant \$500 - \$1000 for installation

BPC and SUMC still need to approve the sign

- **schoolhouse:** nothing to report
- Academy: routine maintenance and inspections
  - o Backflow failed inspection; estimated \$900 to repair
- Streetlights: discussed earlier
- Plantings on Water St:
  - Planting doing fine; Chris Haris has concerns that the evergreen bushes night cause sight problems and questions the boulder placement,
