Welcome & Meeting Overview

- **BPC Update**: Chris Scanlon gave an update on what the BPC has been busy with.
 - o Parcel 770: the final plats were recorded; nothing else to report at this time.
 - o 1 High St: The Town permit was issued in August 2024 and construction has started.
 - o 309 Market: the property is in the preliminary process of building a new home on the lot. The builder has had 2 preliminary consultations with the BPC in recent months,
 - o RFP for the Town-owned portion of Market Street is in progress.
 - o Water Street parking pad: many meetings were held and the BPC devised a compromise that was the best solution.

Questions / Comments:

- When does the Captial grant money expire? Each capital grant from the State for roadwork on Market Street has different expiration dates, depending on the year the grant was awarded.
- Who owns 309 Market and what is the status of 311 Market? 309 Market is currently owned by a bank; 311 Market is owned by DeedsWells and Montgomery County has a tax lein on the property to be sold at the upcoming tax lein sale.

• Rental & Marketing Report

- o Rentals are up 40% compared to this time last year.
- o Recently hosted Olney Chamber of Commerce event.
- o Will participate at the March Olney Community Olney Community Day

• Community Events

- o The Town would like to hear from Residents what type of events they would like the Town to host.
- o A survey will be developed and sent out to solict feedback.

• Town Infrastructure

- o Schoolhouse: routine maintenance being performed.
 - Some minor carpentry work and exterior painting are planned.
- o Academy: routine maintenance being performed.
 - Possible Dining Room acoustics improvements
 - MHT Grant Awarded will take place soon: masonry repointing, windows, painting

- Streetscape: Regular maintenance as required
 - Parking and greenspace revisions at Water Street entrance was done in 2024.
 - Sidewalks will be power washed and vegetation trimmed as needed.
 - Tree removal and replanting around Town
 - Trail work: MNCPP is planning trail work from Water St to WSSC
- Streetlights
 - New LED light fixtures have been ordered for the Town-owned streetlights; installation should be in May and the Town street light poles will be repainted.
 - The Town is working with Pepco to swap out Pepco lights with LED
- Signage
 - a new parking sign at the corner of High and Church Streets will be erected in the Spring.
- o roads
 - : the gravel roads will be assessed after the recent snow
 - Inconjuction with SHA, the Town will work on plans to modify the intersection of High and Market Streets

Questions / Comments:

- When will the work on the Academy be completed? The Academy building repointing project is in the approval process and expected to be completed by fall 2026.
- There was a discussion about taking out the Pepco streetlights from around Town since there is less traffic.

• FY'25 Budget update

- The FY'25 Budget vs Acutal was reviewed
- Capital Reserves was reviewed,

Ouestions / Comments:

Should the Town spend down the cash reserved and just keep a moderate amount, around \$200K in reserves? Having cash reserves is helpful for getting grants, especially when there is a matching amount needed to secure a grant. There was agreement on the need for better financial forecasting and accruing for larger ticket items

Open Discussion:

- Speed Limit Reduction: SHA has approved a reduction in the speed limit from 30 to 25 miles per hour on MD 97 through the Town
- o Sidewalks: The Town is awaing SHA's fesibilty study for sidewalks along MD 97 through the Town,
