b. 203 Market: change in materials

The site development for 19, 21, 23 & 25 High Street was approved at the August meeting. The site work is expected to start sometime in September.

A Request for Proposal for Owner's Representative for the East Market Street Improvements Project was issued on August 19, 2025. The hiring of an Owner's Representative is the first step in the long-anticipated streetscape design for East Market Street.



Even before the shooting began in 1812 in the declared war between Americans and Britains, Baltimore declared war on other Americans. It started in newsprint and ink, but it ended in flesh and blood. This is a talk about the politics and media of 1812 and how a conflict between Marylanders from different parties—Federalists from Montgomery County and Democratic-

Republicans from Baltimore—became a battle over freedom of the press and changed the nature of political protest.

The picture is a satirical print of the Montgomery County men, who called themselves the Spartan Band, as they stood for freedom of the press before a murderous Baltimore mob.


Need a Recycle Bin?
